STATE LEAGUE 1 I MATCH PREVIEW

The stakes don't get any higher than this! A place in South Australia's top-tier competition, the National Premier League South Australia, is on the line as Sturt Lions and White City clash in this year's State League 1 Grand Final.

Sturt's maiden appearance in the NPL was short lived, relegated after finishing 11th back in 2018, while White City haven't featured in the top-flight since 2015. Both clubs are hungrier than ever and feel they deserve a place amongst the big boys of local football in SA.

This will be the third time the two sides have play one another this season, their two previous encounters played out as cagey affairs ending in goalless draws.

After finishing 2nd on the ladder, Sturt have made their way to the decider by overcoming the already promoted league premiers South Adelaide in their two-leg playoff.

White City on the other hand had to do things the hard way following their fourth place finish. A solid 2-0 victory over Playford City in week 1 of the finals was backed up by a hard-fought 1-2 triumph over West Adelaide,

They then went on to secure their place in the Grand Final putting on a second half masterclass to defeat Panthers 1-3 at at O'Sullivans Beach.

Despite a lack of scoring in their preceding rendezvous, both sides have had no issue finding the back of the net throughout the season. Italian import Gonzalo Rodriguez bagging 17 goals for Sturt in the league and another 4 in the finals series, while Stefan Simic slotted 16 for White City.

Will the Lino Fusco inspired Sturt Lions rise to the occasion or will a reinvigorated White City under the guidance of South Australian football icon Damian Mori make their long awaited return to the top-flight?
