Match Day Process for Coaches and Managers

Team Submission deadlines

- 60 minutes before kick off Submit team (changes can be made after this time)
- 30 minutes prior to kick off Confirm team (no more changes can be made without consultation with referee)

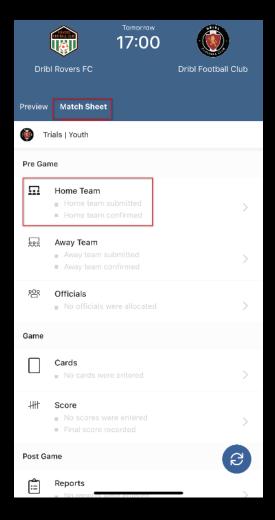
Key Match Day Steps

- ✓ Mark Players, Coaches and Managers as Available
- ✓ Assign shirt numbers
- ✓ Select your goalkeeper and captain
- ✓ Select your starting 11

- ✓ Unselect any players not participating/unavailable
- ✓ Submit Team
- ✓ Confirm Team







Note: you will not be able to perform match day tasks if the club administrator steps of mapping and approving members to teams have not been completed

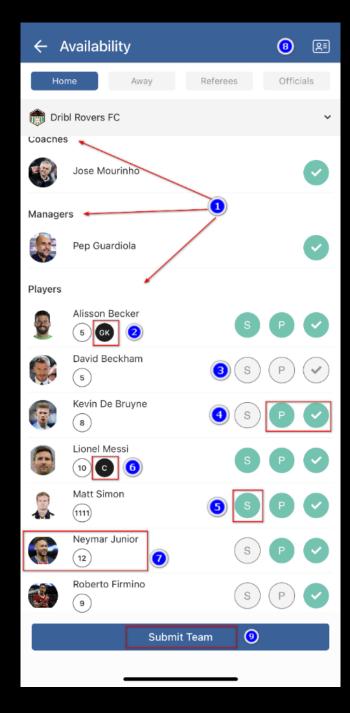

How to Complete your Match Sheet via Dribl

Find the relevant match and corresponding match sheet

- Ensure you are logged in to the Dribl app as a coach/manager/club admin with Reporter access (<u>you</u> <u>will not be able to perform match day tasks if this has</u> <u>not been completed</u>)
- 2. Click on the Fixtures tab and find the relevant fixture or use the filters at the top of the page to narrow down your search
- 3. Select the relevant fixture
- 4. Select the match sheet tab and then select if you are the home or away team (the first listed team is home and second team is the away team)



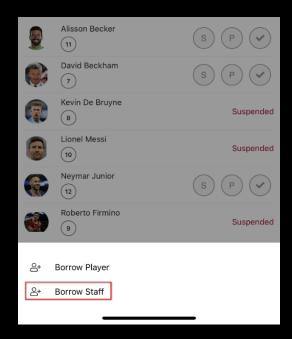


Perform all Pre-Match Tasks

Once you have located your Match Sheet and team, the availability screen will allow you to prepare your match sheet and complete the following tasks

- 1. Specify which coaches, managers and players are participating in the match
- 2. Select your goalkeeper
- 3. If any players are unavailable/not playing ensure they are not ticked and remain a grey unticked circle
- 4. Select the players who are (A) available, they will be listed with a green tick and (P) for Playing (this will be your bench players)
- 5. Allocate your starting 11 by selecting (S) for Starting
- 6. Select your captain
- 7. Allocate shirt numbers
- 8. Borrow players, coaches and managers if required
- 9. Submit Team (must be completed 60 minutes prior to kick off)





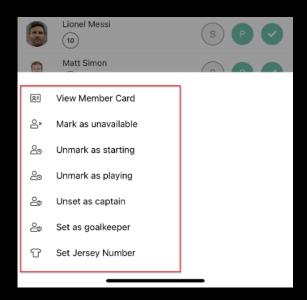
Note: Club admins, coaches and managers MUST
ensure borrowed players meet the relevant
Competition Rules and Regulations in regards to
player movement and eligibility. The onus is on the
club and team to ensure the Competition Rules and
Regulations are not breached

DRIBL

How to borrow players and team officials

- The players, coaches and team officials that are available for selection on the match sheet are those that have been mapped to the relevant team via your Club Administrators
- Players are mapped to a team they predominately play with and you can then borrow players from other teams to fill in on match day
- You can also borrow any registered coach or team official ensuring they are registered and hold the appropriate qualifications
- To borrow a member, select the + icon on the top right hand corner
- Select the relevant role and search for the member and then select them onto the match sheet
- Ground Stewards are to be added under the officials tab, a short video is included at the end of this document

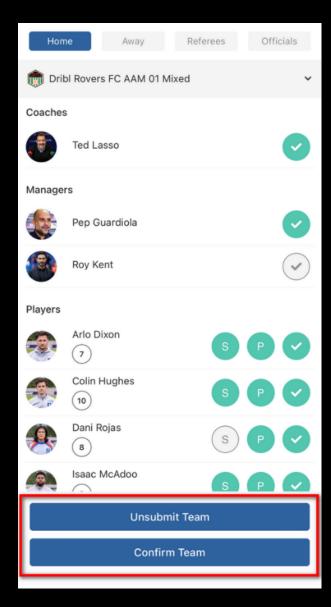




How to modify match sheet fields

- Click and hold on the participants name you wish to modify, this will launch the additional options box
- Select the data field you wish to modify and make the relevant changes

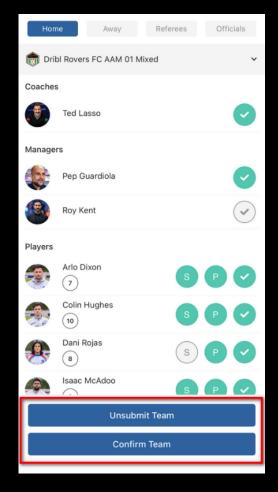




Team Submission

- Once you have completed the match sheet steps above and finalised your starting line up, substitutes, shirt numbers and team officials click on the submit team button
- This step MUST be completed 60 minutes prior to kick off
- If a change needs to be made due to injury or player availability and the opposition has yet to confirm your team, you can select 'unsubmit team' and make the required changes





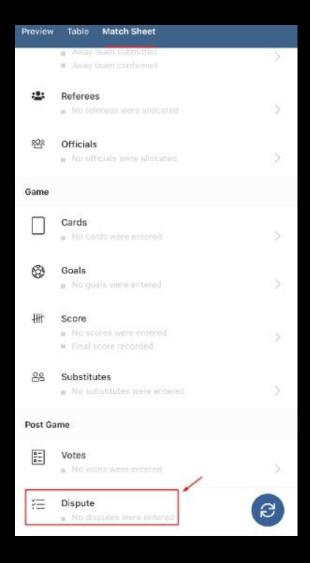
Note: Once teams are confirmed you can no longer modify your team selection. If any changes are required you will need to advise the referee who will be able to un-confirm the team and allow the changes to be made. Any changes will need to be in line with the Competition Rules and Regulations

DRIBL

Confirm Opposition Team

- Teams will be required to confirm their opponent's team as part of the match day process
- Select the oppositions team tab
- Review the opposition's match sheet checking all information has been completed and their line-up is correct
- If there is a discrepancy in the opposition team a dispute may be lodged via the app
- This step MUST be completed 30 minutes prior to kick off





Note: Disputes must be raised within 24 hours of the match being completed

DRIBL

Post Match

- Post match statistics such as goal scorers, substitutes,
 yellow and red cards will be completed by the referee
- Once the match sheet is completed by the referee, team managers and coaches should check all statistics and information entered is correct
- If a situation occurs where a team believes an error has been made, a dispute can be raised within the app which will be reviewed by Football SA
- Injuries if an injury needs to be reported on the match sheet the team manager is to notify the referee who will add this as a report. Alternatively please contact the relevant Competition Administrator to add the injury * note an enhancement will soon allow managers to complete this task





Important Note

- Players can not be manually added to match sheets as per previous seasons
- Players will need to be registered and approved on both Play Football and Dribl prior to being able to participate in any games
- As such, these steps will need to be completed at least
 1 business day prior to the match. If they are not on the
 Dribl match sheet they can not play
