Definitions	Add: Competition Management System (Dribl) 'Team sheet' amended to 'Match Sheet' Add: Senior Women's Competition	
Throughout Document	Amend 'Team Sheets' to 'match sheets'.	Amended in accordance with Dribl terminology.
46	Additional sub-clause: Any prizemoney received will be allocated against any debts of a Club in the first instance.	Formalise what occurs in practice.
4 (9)	New sub-clause: Football SA may provide guidelines prior to the commencement of the Season which are required to be adhered to.	Playing kit guidelines are provided ahead of each season. This amendment formalises the process.

34. (2)	Remove sub-clause.	Football SA provides direction prior to each pre-season stipulating time required to submit request for match officials. This may vary from year to year.

36 (1)	In each season, Football SA shall conduct competitions. Final composition	Football SA administers more than Senior Men, Women and Juniors. Purpose of change is to not limit to just those competitions.
37 (1)	If a team is withdrawn before all teams have played each other once, all matches will be recorded as a no played game. All goal scorer statistics and referee votes gained in Competition Fixtures played involving the withdrawn Team will be removed. All other statistical information will be retained, i.e. disciplinary.	Provide further clarity on what occurs to statistical information should a team withdraw during the season.
(2)	Add additional subclause: All disciplinary records will be retained	
38 (8)	New clause: If a Match Official/s attends and the game is forfeited, the club is required to pay 50% of the prescribed match official fee.	Provide clarity on match official payment in the event the match is forfeited on match day.

39 (2)	Remove initials.	Amended to reflect process on dribl.
(3)	The match sheet is to be submitted as specified within the relevant competition operating regulations.	
(5) (6)	Remove "to the match official".

60 (3)	New clause	Alignment with FA National Registration Regulations.
