Summary of changes – *Senior Men’s Cup Competition*

| 5. | Match Sheet process | To reflect Dribl process. |
| f. | Clubs may list up to six (6) substitutes. One substitute must be a goalkeeper. | To reflect amendment to FA Australia Cup Regulations. |
| 6. c. g. | <p>Substitution of players</p> <p>Teams can name up to six (6) substitutes on their match sheets and must include at least one (1) goalkeeper. If no goalkeeper is listed, only five (5) substitutes may be submitted on a match sheet. A team may use a maximum of five (5) substitutes in normal time.</p> <p>If the game requires extra time, teams will each have one (1) additional substitution opportunity and is permitted to use an extra substitute. Substitutions may also be made before the start of extra time and at half-time in extra time. For clarification, a team can use a maximum of five substitutes up to the end of normal time. Once the game goes into extra-time, a sixth substitute may be used.</p> | <p>To reflect amendment to FA Australia Cup Regulations.</p> <p>To accommodate additional substitutions with increased substitutes list amended in Rule 5.f. and 6.c</p> |
