MATCH PREVIEW

The 2025 Apex Steel Women's National Premier League Grand Final – 6, Sept 2025 Adelaide Comets v Campbelltown City

It is difficult to write about this season's WNPL Grand Final without firstly referencing and acknowledging West Adelaide who, despite not featuring in the final itself, can firmly and fairly be regarded as the best club side in the WNPL this season.

"Westies" won the 2025 WNPL/WSL Pre-season Cup in February and then the Apex Steel WNPL/WSL Cup in July. The side also completed the league home & away fixtures without a single defeat. Kosta Jaric proving, yet again, to be one of the top coaches in the state after an outstanding season with his team.

West Adelaide were just 8 minutes away from securing a Grand Final berth in their qualifying final game against Comets. Niina Yamada had scored very early for West only for that to be canceled out by a Emily Heazlewood goal for Comets very late in the fixture to take the game to extra time. Heazlewood scored again for Comets before Chrissy Panagaris killed the game with Comets' third goal in the 100th minute.

This 3-1 win launched Joel Porter's Comets into the Grand Final as if impolitely skipping some kind of queue.

None of this should suggest that Comets be deprived of a seat at the Grand Final dinner table. The side finished second on the WNPL ladder and only lost three games in the home & away season (one of which was a 3-1 home defeat to, yes, you guessed it, Campbelltown City on a bitterly cold night under the gum trees at Ellis Park).

MATCH PREVIEW

Campbelltown and Comets met earlier in the season at Steve Woodcock Sports Centre where Comets were 2-0 victors. So, heading into this weekend's Grand Final, it's honours even - they've beaten each other once each in the home & away season.

Campbelltown actually took a while to find their feet, sorry, their boots, in the Apex Steel WNPL. Promoted from the WSL at the end of 2024, they opened the 2025 campaign with a 0-3 home loss to Metro United but there were signs that this was a team that would hold its own in its first top tier season since a difficult 2017 when they lost all 21 league games and conceded 155 goals.... whilst scoring just 6.

Their turning point, for me as an onlooker, was their Round 8 game at Adelaide City Park. Two goals from Monique Rechichi gave the visitors a 2-0 win to lift them off the foot of the table. They followed this up two rounds later with a 2-2 draw at Metro United, courtesy of goals from their USA and Canadian players, Madelyn Lauro and Aleisha Ganieff respectively. And from those two games onward, they never looked back.

Campbelltown still relied on results elsewhere to qualify for finals football and they only secured a Top 5 Finals berth in the last round when WT Birkalla and Football NTC both lost their final matches to drop out of Finals contention.

Campbelltown players to watch...

The obvious, and towering, Chelsie Dawber who signed form Adelaide United at the end of the A-League season, is a proven attacking threat. However, the team's top league goalscorer is actually Marina Asada who goes about her business with all the effectiveness of an accomplished secret agent. Monique Rechichi, still only a youngster, has also had a fine season in midfield from where she plays a physical and unafraid game. She has 8 league goals to her name in 2025. Finally, there's the diminutive left back Siena Covino who is the only member of the squad who featured in the 2017 season.

MATCH PREVIEW

Adelaide Comets players to watch Chrissy Panagaris has hit form at just the right time of the season having scored in every game she's played over the last eight rounds. The side also features last years' WNPL player of the year, Anastasia Willoughby in their ranks. Emily Heazlewood and Georgie Nicola are the joint top scorers on the league on 11 each and, at the other end of the park, goalkeeper Madison Melino is a class act.

This Grand Final is impossible to predict. Both sides have triumphed over the overwhelming 2025 favourites, West Adelaide, and both sides come into this game in red hot form. Much will perhaps depend on who can control the midfield and supply the forward line. Will Kira Glinz reign supreme in the midfield for Campbelltown (as she did versus West Adelaide) or will the Sasaki sisters rule for Comets.

It promises to be an intriguing and highly anticipated final....


